Burial

This option includes:

- **Professional Fee** - covers personal attendance and full funeral arrangement process.
- **Uplift Transfer to Funeral Home** - from place of residence, hospital or hospice
- **Standard Embalming**
Post mortem embalming will incur an additional \$100 plus GST
- **Casket 6'1 - Standard-lid Wood Veneer (Matt finish)**
A range of other caskets are also available for selection and priced on application.
- **Hearse transfers x 3 within the Wellington region**
After hours / Weekend transfers may incur additional charges
- **Death Certificate** - from Births, Deaths & Marriages
- **Standard Burial Plot & Interment at Whenua Tapu Cemetery**
Includes grave mats and lowering device. Other Council fees are additional.

The Professional Fee includes the following:

- Personal attendance of an experienced Funeral Director
- Consultation with family and receiving of instructions
- Preparing, embalming and casketing of the deceased
- Preparation and completion of necessary documentation, including registering of the death with Births, Deaths & Marriages.

This fee also covers ongoing overheads such as premises, utilities, vehicles, staff salaries, insurances and the provision of a 24 hour on-call service.

Hearse Transfer: Funeral homes are best equipped to deal with this area particularly in the first instance i.e. from place of death. Our vehicles and equipment are specifically designed to carry out an uplift of a deceased person effectively and safely.

Embalming: Essentially this function is to ensure disinfection and preservation during the funeral period, thus most funeral directors consider it necessary for this very reason. There is an added necessity if viewing of the deceased is to take place, as it ensures a more natural appearance and removes any health hazard. Embalming is also important if the deceased is to be transported any distance.

Embalming is a skilled process and should only be performed by trained practitioners. High standards, as promoted by the NZ Embalmers Association, are to be maintained.

Casket: A range of caskets are supplied with a view to meeting personal, cultural, religious and financial preferences.

Whenua Tapu Charges: This option covers a standard burial plot and interment fee charged by Porirua City Council. Other costs may be incurred dependent on individual requirements i.e. Double Depth, Out of District, Extra Width, Over-sized Burial Row and After hours / Saturday Fees.

Each Cemetery has their own pricing schedule i.e. Taita, Akatarawa, Karori/Makara and Awatapu. The relevant cemetery charges will simply replace Whenua Tapu's charges where applicable.

Your Funeral Director will be happy to discuss and assist you with any other requirements additional to this Funeral option i.e. Newspaper Notice, Casket Flowers and Order of Service Sheets.

You may also be eligible for the WINZ Funeral Grant. If so, this may be automatically deducted from the funeral account, provided necessary documentation is provided.
